ID cards are used to identify Marines and their families. Without an ID card, you can't use base shops, child care, and health care.



You need an ID card to visit a base. A person checks the card at the front gate.

The **commissary** is a market where Marines buy food. The **Post Exchange (PX)** is like the malls in most towns. Marines can buy clothing there.



A **Marine** base has shops, banks, and places to eat.
