Life in ancient Egypt

What did people wear?

People only wore light clothes, because it was very hot. They wore sandals made of palm leaves or they went barefoot. Slaves, workers and children were often naked.

What did they work?

Many Egyptians worked as farmers on the fields. Others helped to build the pyramids and temples. Weavers made beautiful clothes and sold their goods. People paid with food, salt and other things.

What did they eat?

The Egyptians had lots of different food. They hunted fish, ducks, geese. The farmers had sheep, cattle, goats, pigs, and later horses. So they had wool, milk, meat and leather. They also planted lots of vegetables and fruit.

What did people do in their free time?

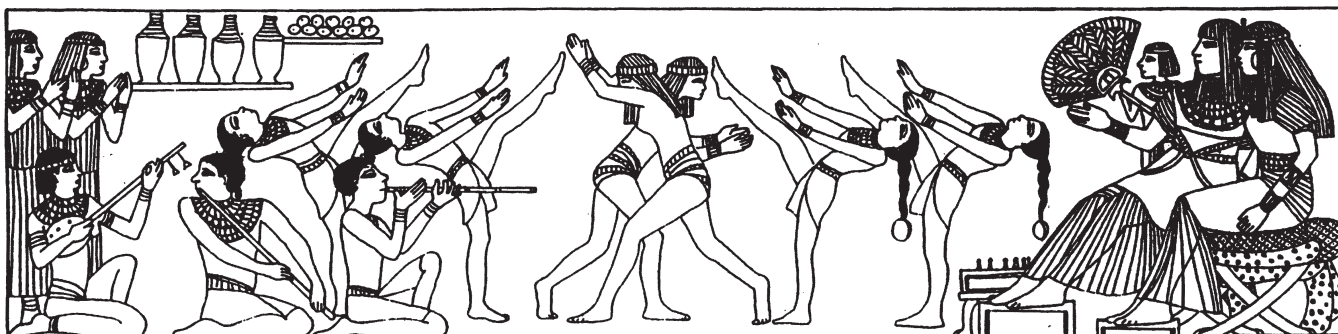
Hunting and fishing were the most popular sports for rich Egyptians. They often gave parties with lots of food and drink.

Musicians dancers, singers acrobats and jugglers were there to entertain the guests.

Children played with balls and toy animals made of wood.

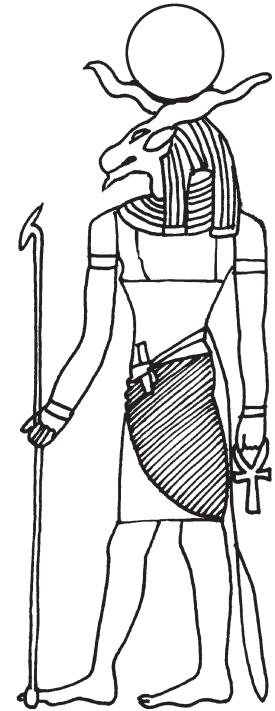
