- The Equator divides the Earth into **east-west/north-south** 1
- The Earth rotates every 24 **minutes/hours/days** 3
- Continent divided into two: **America/Africa/Australia** 2
- Live in the Antarctic: **people/tigers/birds** 1
- Covers 1/8th of land: **deserts/water/ice** 2
- 3/4 of the Earth is covered by **trees/water/mountains** 5

- At the Equator it's: **dry/hot/cold** 3
- The Equator divides the Earth into: **oceans/hemispheres/continents** 1
- A continent in the south: **Europe/England/Australia** 5

Light green is from 200-400m

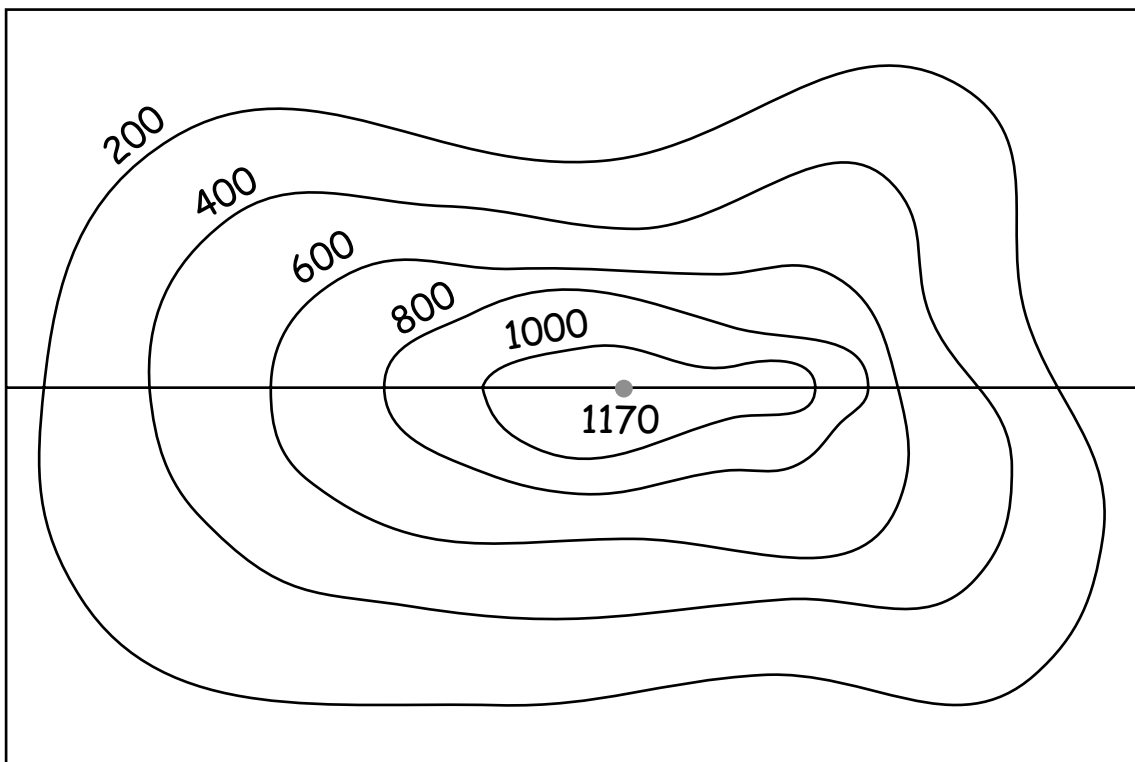
Yellow is from 400-600m

Draw a ski hut at 1000m.

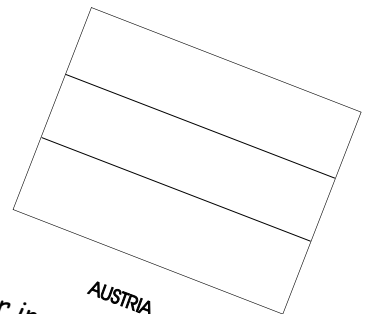
