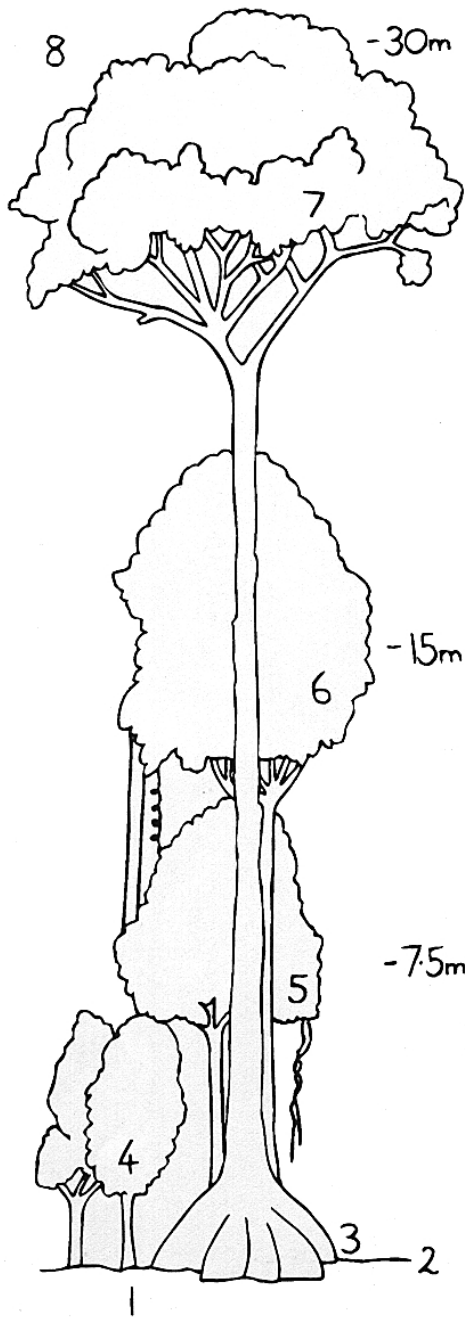












The Tropical Rainforest

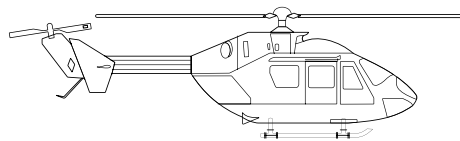
